

Small Grants Fund Criteria

1. The activity must be directly related to projects based in the CV34 postcode area.
2. The lead applicant should be a church or organisation with a Christian foundation or in partnership with a faith based community.
3. The activity needs to be based in the local community (within Warwick) and to have local community involvement in identifying needs, initiating community responses and running the project.
4. The activity must be open to all regardless of faith, ethnic origin, disability, gender or sexual orientation.
5. The lead applicant must have charitable purposes.
6. The activity must be a new initiative or a proposal to expand the work you are doing.
7. The activity must demonstrate sustainability where possible.
8. Any unspent grant must be returned.
9. A 6 month and 12 month monitoring report must be completed.
10. The money can only be used for the project as approved and nothing else, unless a variation has been agreed with Transforming Communities Together Warwick.

Funding will be given to

Projects that seek to transform their communities.

What we do not fund

1. Activities not directly working with people living in Warwick/CV34 area.
2. Activities without church links.
3. Campaigning and fundraising activity.
